

So, who is "Yahshua"?

He is just what we are told He is. He is the Son of Yahweh.

His name answers that question. The very best example I can offer lay in the customs of many peoples around the world today. Men name their sons after themselves. Miguel from Mexico names his son Mige or Miguel (Mike or Michael). It is very common for the father to bear the full and proper name, while the son carries some abbreviated form of the father's name. Michael's son might be called Mikie, or simply Mike. Thomas' son would be called Tom. Yahweh's Son was marked with Yahweh's name in that His name begins with the poetic short form of Yahweh,... "Yah". "Yah" is the Almighty's poetic short name. So, we should expect Yahweh to mark His Son with "Yah", and He did. He named Him "Yahshua". "Shua" means "in you". Yahshua means "Yah in you".

Yahshua is the Son of God. He declared this to the Pharisees and they labeled Him a blasphemer. Yahshua was the Son of God in flesh and in spirit. He was the fleshly Son of Yahweh in that Yahweh begat Him via His seed. On another level, Yahshua is the Son of God in that Yahshua is Yahweh's "Ben-e-Elohim", (Son of Elohim). This BeneElohim can only be "created" by Yahweh. Only spirit is BeneElohim. Yahshua is the Son of God via Yahweh's seed, as a fleshly man, and the Son of God via BeneElohim, spirit.

Now, go to Genesis 1 and 2 and learn about Adam. In chapter 1, Adam and Eve are "created". In chapter 2, they are "formed/made". These were two separate events. Adam and Eve are created together in chapter 1, and at this event they are created in "His image". So, I ask you, what image is Yahweh? His image is spirit. So, what was created in this event? Adam and Eve's spirit. That is chapter 1. What takes place in chapter 2? In chapter 2 Adam's flesh is formed of the dust of the earth, and Yahweh discovers he is lonely and needs a helper, then lays Adam down for a good sleep, pulls the rib and makes Eve. These are two completely separate events.

Now, which event is "dominion of the world" associated with?

When Adam and Eve's spirit was created, Yahweh gave dominion of the world to their spirit. Yahweh never gave this authority to their flesh. Therefore, when their spirit died, man lost dominion of the world. And this event is exactly what Yahshua reversed with His triumph in everything He did in walking the Mosaic Law perfectly. He gave us the opportunity to have Yahweh's BeneElohim back, and with it, dominion of the earth. And with this power and dominion, we are given power over dark angels around us all over the world. With this accomplishment, "Yahshua" gave us "Yah in you". His name tells the entire story!

Now, lets rewind, step back, and look at this whole thing from a broader perspective: Yahshua was labeled the second Adam. How did He earn this label? Well, Adam's spirit was created first, then later his flesh was made, and the two bodies dwelled together. Well, Yahshua's spirit was also created first, then joined His flesh when John baptized Yahshua in the Jordan, at which time these two Sons of God bodies dwelled together, just as Adam's did.

Both Adam and Yahshua are different from every other man on earth in that they both descended directly from Yahweh. Both spirits were created, but Adam's flesh was made by Yahweh's hands with clay, while Yahshua's flesh was begat by Yahweh's seed. All other

men are born of men. Adam and Yahshua are the only two who were different. They are the only two who are direct descendents of Yahweh.

Then we learn from Enoch that Yahshua was "Selected" by Yahweh (and called the "Selected One") and set above all the angels in heaven and "hidden" by Yahweh in the throne room prior to the time of Enoch. Enoch learns of all this from his escort angel when he visited heaven and the throne room. And so it is true, before Abraham was, Yahshua existed.

Who is Yahshua? He is the Son of God, in more ways than one! And His name tells the entire story!

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
